The Foundation will award scholarships to Hispanic undergraduate students or college graduates who intend to sit for the 2021 LSAT exam. The award is intended to help defray the expense of an LSAT review course.

In order to be eligible to receive this scholarship, an applicant must be:

- 1) A Texas resident;
- 2) Of Hispanic/Latino descent;
- 3) A junior or senior college student or a college graduate; and
- 4) Registered to take the LSAT in 2021.

The HBAA Charitable Foundation will consider each applicant’s:

- 1) Educational debt burden/financial need;
- 2) Record of community involvement; and
- 3) Academic record.

Please complete this application and submit it, along with:

- **An unofficial transcript;**
- **Resume;**
- **a statement of interest** (indicating your law school plans and the name/cost of the LSAT prep course you intend to use); **and**
- **a statement of financial need, including current educational debt burden.**
- Applicants may also submit an additional brief statement (no more than 400 words) of why the applicant should be considered for the scholarship. This statement is optional.
